The hosting organisation at a glance:

The CRPG – Center for Professional Rehabilitation of Gaia started operating in 1992, under an agreement signed in 1991 between the IEFP – Institute for Employment and Professional Training, CERCIGAIA – Cooperative for the Education and Rehabilitation of Unadapted Citizens, and ADFA - Association for the Disabled of the Armed Forces, with the objective of:

- Training and professional rehabilitation of people with functional diversity associated with disabilities, with a view to their inclusion or reinsertion in the labor market;
- Provision of consultancy services to companies, insurance companies and hospitals;
- Prescription and supply of support products.

Practicalities:

The city of Porto is the second-largest city in Portugal, known as the capital of the North, as opposed to the more central Lisbon. Porto is historic and lively, rich in cultural attractions so that its centre was proclaimed World Heritage by UNESCO in 1996.

A) Travel to Porto

• ARRIVE IN PORTO BY PLANE

Francisco Sà Carneiro Airport is 11 km from Porto; it is an efficient and modern facility.

Once landed, you can reach the city centre by:

Metro: the airport is connected to the city by the Linha Violeta (Purple Line). This line operates every day from 06:00 in the morning to 01:00 at night and takes about 30-35 minutes to reach the city centre; you can easily get off at Trindade or Bolhão stations. The ticket can be purchased at the ticket machines of the metro station; the ticket (Z4) has a cost of \in 2.45 and is valid for 1 hour and 15 minutes. This type of ticket is eventually rechargeable.




Taxi: taxi services are available throughout the city and await travellers at the airport exit day and night. They can carry up to 4 passengers; the journey to the centre usually costs 20-25€, a surcharge is applied for luggage with volumes greater than 55x35x20 cm.

HOW TO GET TO CLIP HOTEL FROM THE AIRPORT

The easiest and cheapest way to arrive at **Clip Hotel** from the airport is by Metro. You can make the Metro trip taking the **Linha Lilás (Line E)** to the **Trindade** station and there change to the **Yellow Line (Line D)** in the direction of **Santo Ovidio** and leave at **João de Deus Station**.





HOW TO GET TO RESTAURANTE DECASTRO GAIA FROM CLIP HOTEL

Espaço Porto Cruz (Porto Cruz Place) is a project to celebrate Porto wine culture, combining contemporaneity and tradition. It was created as an informative, expositive and leisure place.

If you go up to the third floor, you'll find **Restaurant deCastro Gaia.** Here, you could taste regional products with a touch of modernity.

The trip: From the hotel, you can walk to catch **bus number 900** at the bus stop, **João de Deus**, in the direction of **Cordoaria**. Then, jump off the stop **Ponte Luíz I** and walk 300 m to the restaurant.
