# Activities



## Activity 1:

Landscaping and conditioning of paths. You will help to improve the Bielsa Carnival Forest by recovering autochthonous species and participating in the conditioning of the path so that it can be accessible to everyone who wants to enjoy an original walk in the open air.



## Activity 2:

Promote and recover the Barucoteca leisure centre, a leisure space for the youngest children in the area. You will participate in the elaboration of activities and annual programming of the activities of the toy library as well as carrying out handicraft activities to decorate the aforementioned paths with children. You will also adapt the activities to children with disabilities.



## Activity 3 (complementary activity):

To carry out intergenerational activities with the elderly in the area, where volunteers and children will participate in activities with the elderly as a preventive action against isolation and feelings of loneliness of the elderly.

A set of flats adapted so that all our visitors, with or without disabilities, feel at home and can move around with total freedom and independence.

Located in a privileged setting in the Aragonese Pyrenees, it is aimed at all those who want to get to know the Sobrarbe region and especially those who have problems when it comes to carrying out normal leisure and free time activities due to the lack of areas adapted to their possibilities.

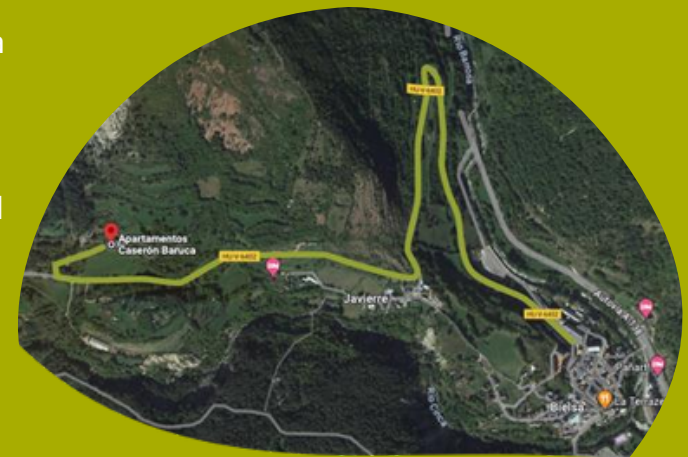


## About Bielsa
