

Thematic Incubator: Services for People on the Autistic Spectrum

Programme

Background

A number of EPR members have shared that they are working with an increasing number of people with Autistic Spectrum Disorder in different types of services. They would like to explore what other members are doing, and see if there is potential for further cooperation.

According to the EPR mutual learning model, a “thematic incubator” is for when organisations want to share ideas, thoughts, needs, experiences on a specific theme, but they don’t know yet the path we could follow together afterwards. The aim is that the meeting acts an incubator for ideas and other mutual learning activities that would be more results-oriented.

EPR has also brought Autism Europe in to present their work to build the relationship with them and to learn about their initiatives and possible further collaboration.

Objectives

- Mutual learning on services for autistic people with a focus on social inclusion, education and employment
- Identifying success factors and successful practices
- Discussing challenges and barriers to the provision of services for service providers across Europe.
- Investigating if there is an interest for further work on this topic within EPR and with Autism Europe and on what topic.
