Welcome



On behalf of EPR and LADAPT, welcome to Paris! Often called the City of Light, it earned its nickname after becoming one of Europe's first cities to adopt widespread street lighting in the 17th century, transforming nighttime safety and symbolizing intellectual enlightenment. Beneath its elegant boulevards lies a hidden world: the Catacombs, where the remains of roughly six million people were transferred in the 18th century when cemeteries overflowed.

The city's most iconic landmark, the Eiffel Tower, was originally meant to be temporary - built for the 1889 World's Fair and scheduled for dismantling after 20 years until its usefulness as a radio tower saved it.

Paris also has a playful side: it famously has only one stop sign, a curiosity in a place where roundabouts and traffic lights rule the streets. And while millions flock to the Louvre today, few remember that this massive museum began as a medieval fortress before becoming a royal palace. Together, these layers of history and oddities make Paris a city that always offers something unexpected.

Arc de Triomphe

- Commissioned by Napoleon in 1806, it honors those who fought and died for France during the French Revolutionary Wars and the Napoleonic Wars;
- Beneath it lies the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier from World War I, with an eternal flame that has been rekindled daily since 1923.

Centre Pompidou

- Opening in 1977, it was deliberately built “inside-out,” exposing pipes, escalators, and structural elements;
- A landmark of modern architecture and a major center for contemporary art, design, and cultural experimentation.



Luxembourg Gardens

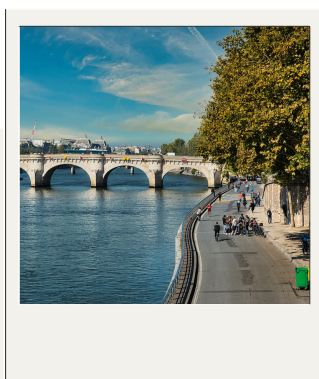
- Created in 1612 by Marie de Medici, who wanted a garden reminiscent of her childhood in Florence;
- A blend of French formal design with Italian inspiration, featuring geometric paths, fountains, and sculptures.

Montmartre Neighborhood

- Legends like Picasso, Toulouse-Lautrec, and Van Gogh lived or worked here, shaping modern art movements.
- It was also a center of cabaret culture, including the early days of the Moulin Rouge.



Everyday Paris experiences: Café terraces, boulangeries and Seine picnics

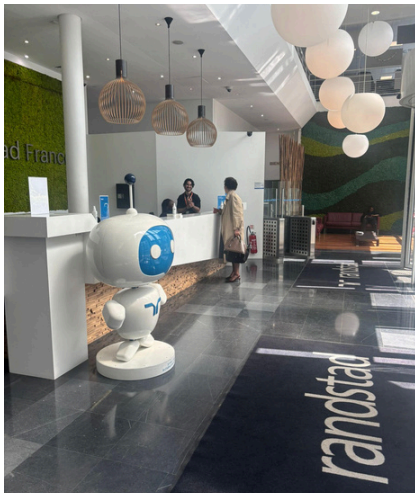


GOOD TO KNOW

Groupe Randstad France



The Conference will be held at the **Groupe Randstad France** building, located at 276 Avenue du Président Wilson, 93211 Saint-Denis La Plaine, France

Conference room: The Conference room is located on the first floor. There will be signs ('EPR Annual Conference 2026') to guide you there.

Groupe Randstad France is a company with deep-rooted commitments to inclusive employment and disability inclusion, such as its creation of Kliff par Randstad, France's first national temporary employment network dedicated to recruiting and supporting workers with disabilities. IMPORTANT

Please note that upon entering the building, **you will be asked to leave your passport or ID at the reception desk in exchange for a Randstad badge.** This badge will allow you to move freely in and out of the building. Your identification document will be securely stored in a safe.

You will be able to collect your passport or ID at the end of each conference day.

Although this process is usually quick and smooth, we recommend arriving 10–15 minutes before the start of the conference registration and welcome refreshments (9:00 CEST) to allow enough time for check-in.

After receiving your badge at the entrance, you will still need to register at the EPR Conference registration desk, located just outside the conference room.



From Gare du Nord



Option 1 (fastest): Train (Transilien H) + walk

🕒 15–25 min | 💰 €2.55

What ticket to buy:


- Buy 1 Metro–Train–RER ticket (€2.55) at a machine in Gare du Nord
- You can use it immediately for this trip

Steps:

1. Inside Gare du Nord, follow signs for Transilien trains (Line H)
2. Pass the ticket gates using your €2.55 ticket
3. Take the train direction: Saint-Denis / Persan / Luzarches
4. Get off at Saint-Denis station (1 stop)
5. Exit the station and walk 15 minutes toward Avenue du Président Wilson
6. Arrive at your destination



Option 2: RER D + walk

 25–35 min |  €2.55

What ticket to buy:

- Buy 1 Metro–Train–RER ticket (€2.55)

Steps:

- In Gare du Nord, follow signs for RER D
- Enter gates using your ticket
- Take RER D (northbound)
- Get off at Stade de France–Saint-Denis station
- Walk 10–15 minutes to Avenue du Président Wilson
- Arrive at your destination

Option 3: Metro Line 13 + walk

 30–40 min |  €2.55



What ticket to buy:

- Buy 1 Metro–Train–RER ticket (€2.55)

Steps:

1. From Gare du Nord, enter the metro with your ticket
2. Follow signs to connect to Metro Line 13
3. Take Line 13 direction: Saint-Denis – Université
4. Get off at Saint-Denis–Porte de Paris station
5. Walk 10–15 minutes to your destination

Option 5; Taxi / Uber

 15–25 min |  €10–€20

What to do:

1. Go outside Gare du Nord
2. Take a taxi or order Uber
3. Give address: 276 Avenue du Président Wilson, Saint-Denis



TIP

Always keep your ticket until the end of your journey (there can be inspections at exits). If using paper tickets, don't lose or bend them - they can stop working

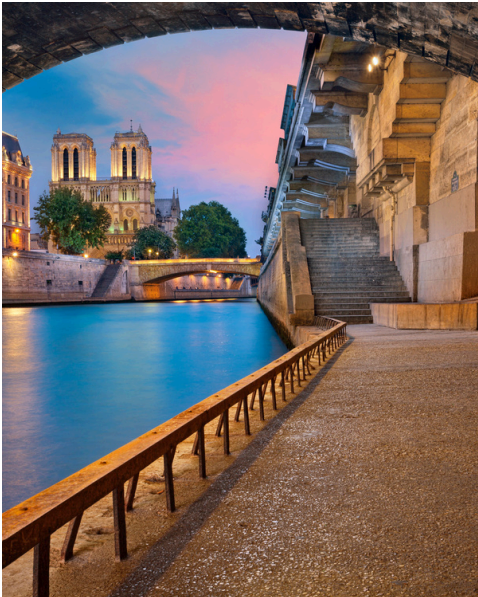
